SC has not stayed BHC order quashing attachment of 63 moons' assets under MPID Act

• SC has asked to maintain status quo

Mumbai, September 24, 2019:

The Supreme Court has not issued a stay in the Special Leave Petition (SLP) filed by Maharashtra Government and others, challenging the Bombay High Court order quashing attachment of assets of 63 moons technologies limited under the Maharashtra Protection of Investors Deposits (MPID) Act.

The Supreme Court has asked to maintain status quo till the final hearing. Maharashtra Government had sought for stay on the BHC order, which the Supreme Court has refused. The next hearing in the matter is scheduled for November 27, 2019.
